

Over time, Danish Freemasonry developed through several systems before adopting the Swedish Rite in the mid-19th century, which remains in use today. This system is a distinctly Christian-oriented and fully integrated structure of eleven degrees, organised in three divisions, reflecting a tradition of continuity, spiritual depth, and cohesive progression.

Today, the Order comprises 92 lodges throughout Denmark and approximately 6,500 members. Together with closely affiliated Masonic bodies working in concord with the United Grand Lodge of England, regular Freemasonry in Denmark encompasses approximately 7,800 brethren.

Across time and distance, Freemasonry continues to unite men in a shared pursuit of moral integrity, personal development, and brotherly fellowship. While our respective traditions may differ in form and expression, we remain closely connected through these common foundations.

It is in this spirit of shared values and mutual respect that we extend our warmest greetings and best wishes for your bicentennial celebration. May your Grand Lodge continue to flourish and to contribute to the betterment of its members and society for generations to come.
